Preface


Welcome to the third smallest district of Vienna. The district with the post code 1070 was one of the first areas outside of the city center where people once settled – you are here: in Neubau.


7 facts to impress with when you talk about the 7th district

- 1. IN 2018 32,467 PEOPLE LIVED IN NEUBAU.
- 52 PERCENT OF ALL HOMES IN NEUBAU ARE ONE-PERSON HOUSEHOLDS - THE HIGHEST PERCENTAGE OF ALL THE DISTRICTS.
- 3. THE 7TH DISTRICT STRETCHES OVER ONLY 0.62 SQUARE MILES. THE ONLY DISTRICTS IN VIENNA THAT ARE SMALLER ARE MARIAHILF AND JOSEFSTADT WHICH ARE CONNECTED TO NEUBAU IN THE SOUTH AND THE NORTH.
- 4. THE FIRST SETTLEMENTS IN THE AREA DATE BACK TO 1100...
- 5. ...IN 1202 THE AREA WAS MENTIONED IN A DOCUMENT FOR THE FIRST TIME.
- 6. REMEMBER THE TALE OF THE FOLK SINGER 'DER LIEBE AUGUSTIN' WHO WAS BELIEVED TO BE DEAD AND TOSSED IN A PLAGUE PIT WITH OTHER BLACK DEATH VICTIMS? ACCORDING TO THE STORY THIS PIT IS BELIEVED TO HAVE BEEN CLOSE TO THE CHURCH OF ST. ULRICH. AFTER SLEEPING OFF HIS INTOXICATION HE SANG SO LOUDLY THAT THE GRAVE DIGGERS FOUND HIM AND PULLED HIM OUT.

Tradition and history

Around 1100 settlers took up residence here on the bank of the Ottakringer stream. The district's long history is owed to its ideal geographical location: from its beginning point adjacent to the city center at 180 meters above sea level it gradually goes uphill towards the west where it ends at Gürtel at around 215 meters above the level of the Adriatic sea. Settlements were established along the hilly area which grew to villages and finally turned into a suburban area in which the textile industry thrived. Today this area also known as Brillantengrund still bursts of Viennese tradition and charm.



7. HISTORICAL MAP FROM 1827

Hermanngasse 24-26, hallway on the 2nd story

Visit the historical map from 1827 depicting the streets of Neubau 200 years ago. Take a close look at the 14 drawings of the most beautiful buildings back in the day which were colored by hand. The originator of the map is Carl Graf Vasquez.

8. FROEMMEL'S

Zieglergasse 70, froemmel.at

Since 1967 people with a love for sweets enjoy the traditional delicacies on offer at froemmel's coffee house and confectionery. The tasty lunch menu combines fine quality with typically Viennese cuisine – homemade in the 7^{th} district



9. KAISER STUCK®

Kaiserstraße 32, kaiser-stuck.at

At Kaiser Stuck®, you can get highquality plaster mouldings made from specially hardened plaster. The beautiful alabaster figurines, spectacle nose or the 'ass with ears' fit perfectly into a case and are special gifts for special friends.

10. MITZITANT'

Seidengasse 39 (on the corner of Kaiserstraße), mitzitant.at

As yummy as grandma used to make it! At Mitzitant' you'll get a full Viennese cuisine experience with traditional recipes cooked from seasonal and organic ingredients from the region. Gluten and lactose free choices are available upon request. Taste the passion and enjoy the relaxed Viennese atmosphere.



11. KONSKRIPTIONSNUMMER

Seidengasse 28

Before houses in Vienna had actual addresses they used to be organized by numbers. The number on the sign decorating the façade of Seidengasse 28 reminds us of those times. Seidengasse (silk street) used to be called Fuhrmann(s)gasse (wagoner's street) between 1726 and 1862. You can find the old name on the historical map (first stop on the tour).





The grand façade guessing game








Always on the move

The 7th district has a sporty feel to it. With only 10,903 registered cars Neubau has the second lowest number of cars in Vienna – only surpassed by the district Josef-stadt which is also smaller in size. Most errands are run on foot, by scooter, or on bike. If you want to join in you can use 11.2 miles of cycle tracks, go for a walk in one of the parks, or enjoy a good book on one of the park benches before you rejoin the big city life. Smaller residents and their friends enjoy running free on one of the 16 playgrounds in the area. Make sure to check out the sports opportunities and available activities.

16. RAUCH JUICE BAR










Brilliant souvenirs

It was Joseph II. who summoned immigrants from southern Germany and Görz to bring economic prosperity by producing silk, velvet, and other products related to textile. Because of the great wealth of the manufacturers the suburban area Schottenfeld received the byname Brillantengrund, which means diamond grounds. Although the golden age of silk production lies 200 years back the 7th district is still known for its variety of craft around textile. Locally manufactured and distinguished fabrics are a great souvenir to bring back from Neubau.






